In light of the ongoing epidemic and a state of emergency in Georgia, it is critically important to provide objective information to as many citizens as possible on how to limit the spread of the COVID-19 virus and mitigate its negative effects. As a result, currently we have a comprehensive and up-to-date database of nearly 15,000 people living in 10 regions of Georgia, disaggregated by the listed sub-groups. In the face of the COVID-19 crisis and the critical need for timely and credible information, we are happy to offer our assistance in disseminating such information in Georgia's regions. We can reach those citizens who are left beyond the social networks, as well as those who do not speak Georgian.
